Justification:

1. Do they understand the word illustrator to identify who drew the pictures?
2. Using a variety of words also found on the same page will ensure children are reading and understanding rather than looking for any word that matches an answer
3. Basic comprehension
4. Picture observation
5. Similar words - ensuring good phonics accuracy
6. As in No. 2
7. Children must use the text rather than looking at the picture and guessing
8. 3 & 8 can often be confused by children
9. Children tend to guess if words look familiar so they may go for any option as all are plausible.
10. Synonyms - children must read the text about Jonnie feeling good to be back and understand him being happy.
